MENIGRATOPSIS SVENNILSSONI (AMPHIPODA, LYSIANASSOIDEA) FOUND IN NORTHERN NORWAY




Fig. 1. Known distribution of *Menigratopsis svennilssoni*. The dots represent published records, the star the new record from the Tromsø area in northern Norway.

Menigratopsis svennilssoni Dahl, 1945 is a little-known and rarely recorded lysianassoid amphipod. Since its original description on the base of 5 specimens from the Öresund between Denmark and Sweden, the species has only been reported twice: Just (1976) redescribed M. svennilssoni on the basis of the original specimens, two further animals from the type-locality area, and seven specimens from Bylot Sound and Wolstenholme Fjord in N.W. Greenland, while Vader & Johannessen (1978) reported on a single specimen from near Stavanger in western Norway (Fig. 1). The present note records the presence of M. svennilssoni in the Tromsø area of northern Norway (Fig. 1), where 7 specimens were found in four grab samples from mixed bottoms at depths of

20—50 m in the sounds around the island of Tromsøya, during a study of urban pollution in the area (Oug & Holte 1985). The material is kept in the collection of Tromsø Museum. This occurrence shows once more that *M. svennilssoni* is widespread in the northern Atlantic, and that the paucity of records probably is the results of a somewhat specialized habitat.

I predict that Menigratopsis svennilssoni will be found to be a burrowing species, that tolerates low oxygen tensions in the substrate. This would explain the fact that this shallow-water species is eye-less, and that the adult males are very little modified for swimming. It also is in agreement with the curious circumstance that all European records of M. svennilssoni are from somewhat polluted areas.
