This NISK Journal volume is the published proceedings of the papers presented at The 15th Norwegian Information Security Conference 2022 held on November 29 December 2, 2021 at Gimlemoen Campus and at the Scandic Bystranda Hotel, Kristiansand, as a track under NIKT conference.

The aim of the NISK conference series is to be the principal Norwegian research venue for presenting and discussing developments in the field of ICT security and privacy, and bringing together people from universities, industry, and public authorities. We invited both national and international contributions by researchers, practitioners, and PhD and Master thesis students presenting and discussing new results within ICT security. All accepted papers must be original and not simultaneously submitted to another conference or journal. Contributions can be written in English or in Norwegian. The authors retain the copyright to their published articles.

The programme committee included 14 experts covering the broad field of information security and privacy. We were able to recruit the PC members both from universities, research institutes, industries, and public organisations, both in Norway and abroad. The main load of review work took place in the time period of September through October 2022. The review process was performed in a timely manner thanks to eager responsiveness of the committee members. We used the EasyChair web-based system for the submission, review, and selection process. We received by September in total 13 submissions co-authored by authors both from Norway and abroad. Three double blind reviews were done for each paper. The programme committee accepted 8 of the submissions as regular research papers. All of these 8 contributions were scheduled for presentations at the two day conference programme.

NISK invited keynote speaker Elisabet Haugsbø gave an inspiring and provoking talk with title: "Surveillance in the name of National Security».

The programme committee chair thanks all authors for submitting their papers to the NISK Conference and the program committee members who did the essential job of reviewing the submissions.
