DION's role at NTNU



- Consultant for NTNU board members
- Represent NTNU in the National Doctoral Organization (SiN)
- Hearing body for NTNU internal regulations and initiatives
- Observer at Dean meetings and in the Central Research Committee
- Contact point for labor unions (Tekna, Forskerforbundet, etc.)
- Collaboration with Studenttinget (NTNU student government)
- Focus on broad employee issues: social integration, psychological support, working environment, language issues, etc.

Frequently asked questions...

- Recruitment and salary

- Duty work
 - Too much duty work
 - Duty work is irrelevant
- Supervisor relationship
 - Supervisor wants to control too much
 - Supervisor offers too little guidance
 - Can I change supervisors?

Trade unions in Norway

- What do they do?
 - provide assistance and legal help in case of conflicts
 - can influence your work situation
 - Tekna, FORSKER, etc.
- Tips and tricks:
 - Being secured by a membership in a trade union can be useful for temporary employees!
 - Membership in a union is generally considered positive also by the employers
 - You must be a member of the union for some time before asking for their help
 - Union fees usually not so high
