Challenges for temporary employees

- Many PhD-students get less salary than they are entitled to (according to central & local adjustments)
 - Know your (salary) rights
 - For example 2.500,- extra to every PhD below 450.000 kr
 - 1,3% to all our members (from may 2018)
 - 3% to all PhD-students every 12 months after starting.
 - Check your salary every year, at least every new contract
 - Tekna help our members fix obvious mistakes by talking to HR every week.
- The modern <u>Wage-agreement for government</u> workers organized in <u>Tekna (and Akademikerne)</u>
 - And the most important part translated to English



New regulations

- New government employee law
 - Maximum three year temporary employment before the position becomes permanent
- NTNU policy
 - Increase the use of permanent employment

NIRS example: Tax

- When do you get a national identity number or a Dnumber?
 - When the Tax Administration is informed by the police, they register you in the National Registry. Once they have done this, they will send you a letter with your D number or your national identity number. It usually takes about two weeks for this letter to arrive by mail.

Tax deduction card

- Some people still have to meet with the Tax Administration to get their tax card. You can find information on the Tax Administration's website on how.no.nd/ foreign citizens apply for tax cards (external website).
- Who must still meet with the Tax Administration to get the D number or the national identity number?
 - If you belong to one of these groups, you must still meet with the Tax Administration:
 - EU/EEA nationals
 - Family members of EU/EEA citizens
 - Seasonal workers
